I am writing to introduce myself to you as part of the Exeter College Advice Team, and the lead College Adviser for Braunton Academy. As College Advisers we can help students with their preparations for joining Exeter College after their GCSEs, including providing information about courses and entry requirements, the application and interview processes, and student life and apprenticeships.

We will be available to support you and your young person throughout Year 11. However, we are aware that, despite the disruption to their learning over the past year, Year 10 students may already be thinking about their post-16 options. Students will be given the opportunity to collect a copy of the new School Leavers Course Guide 2022/2023 in September, but we will also be delivering some remaining copies of this year's guide to schools over the coming weeks to enable students to start looking at their course options now, should they wish to.
